PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM REPORT
6TH TO 10TH NOVEMBER 2023**

In Ram Krishna College of Ayurveda and Medical Sciences, 5 days Professional Development program(PDP) was organized from 6th to 10th November 2023. The main objective of the program was to make students and teaching staff aware about the advancements in the program and different courses of BAMS. Also, disseminating important inputs for strengthening their professional skill was second objective which was as important as the first one.

The program commenced with inaugural ceremony of this 5 days event in the presence of Prof. Vijaykumar Agrawal, Vice Chancellor, RKDF University, Dr. V. K. Sethi, Director General Research and Dr. Anoop Katyayan, Principal, RKCHMS.

To start with the tradition and customary approach, Dhanwantari stawan, poojan and lamp lightening was done by the hands of honorable guests.

In the welcome speech, Prof(Dr.) Abhijit B. Patil explained significance of professional development at different stages of life as a student, as a teacher and as a Doctor. He emphasized on periodical conduction of such programs to cope up with new problems and challenges emerging every now and then.

Dr. V. K. Sethi appreciated for initiative of the event and explained importance of professional development in the field of Research.

Prof. Vijaykumar Agrawal emphasized on importance of attending such PDPs for holistic personal development which gives easy success, name and fame in their profession.

Dr. Anoop Katyayan also urged the students and staff to be focused and goal oriented to sit on the top of their profession.

The program has 5 important themes covering different areas from the development approach of students, teachers and Doctors.

On 6th November, Dr. Deepak Jaiswal conducted a session on "Pharmacovigilance in Ayurveda" in which he explained about Adverse Drug Reactions (ADRs) with its causes, timely tracing and reporting. It is important for a Doctor to know contraindications and ADRs of a drug for effective management of a disease. As per him, early detection of ADR is very necessary to avoid future complications.

On 7th November a special session for budding doctors and Medical officers was arranged on "Handling medico-legal issues in medical practice" by Dr. Shatrunjay Markam. In this session, Dr. Shatrunjay gave brief idea about constitution of India and the sections in IPC related to the medical profession. He explained about the care to be taken by a doctor during medical practice and made aware about the rights of a doctor and support from the law in false cases of medical negligence.

On 8th November, Dr. Ajaya Yerne was a key speaker who talked on “Ayurveda for public health”. She briefed about the schemes of Central and State Government of Bharat which are implemented by Ministry of AYUSH for common public on grass root level. According to her, Allopathy can maintain health of a single individual but Ayurveda has a power of maintaining the health of society if followed strictly and scientifically. Following regime described in Ayurveda by every person, building a strong nation is a dream which could be easily transformed into the reality.

On 9th November Dr. Pulkit Rai engaged the students with the topic “Ayurveda for students”. In his lecture, he made the students to know all possible opportunities and scope in their profession after completion of the program. He concluded his talk with the take home message that ‘The sky is the limit for a sincere and hardworking student who recognizes best opportunities from many possibilities’

On 10th November, a special session devoted to Herbal cultivation was arranged and conducted by Dr. Sangram Rajput. Dr. Sangram opened a new door of opportunity for students and doctors to collaborate with farmers for cultivation of organic herbs having more potency and efficacy. Scientific knowledge of any herb by a doctor when combined with traditional knowledge of that herb by a folklore makes the things possible which are never less than a miracle. He gave a new insight to students and staff to tie up with pharma industries to establish them as emerging entrepreneurs.

On the last and concluding day of the Professional Development Program, all speakers were felicitated with a certificate of appreciation and a memento by the hands of Prof. Vijaykumar Agrawal, Vice Chancellor and Prof(Dr.) Abhijit B. Patil, Principal RKCAMS for sharing their knowledge.

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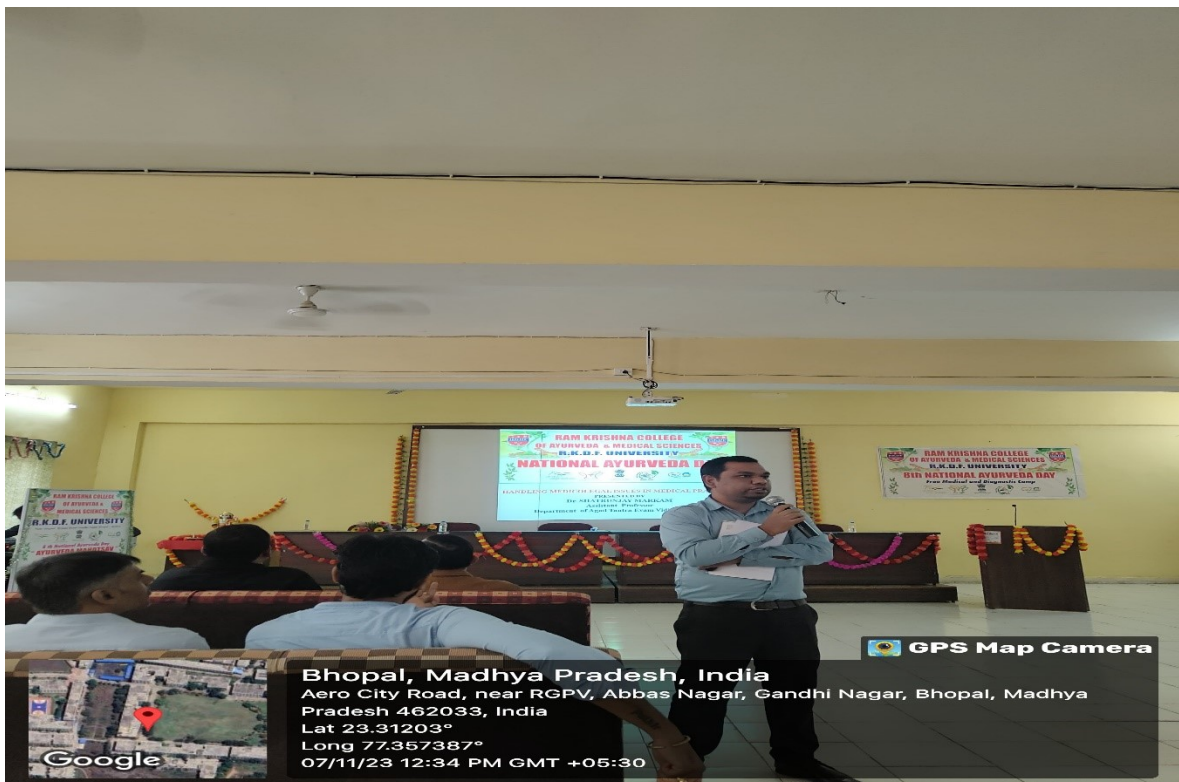

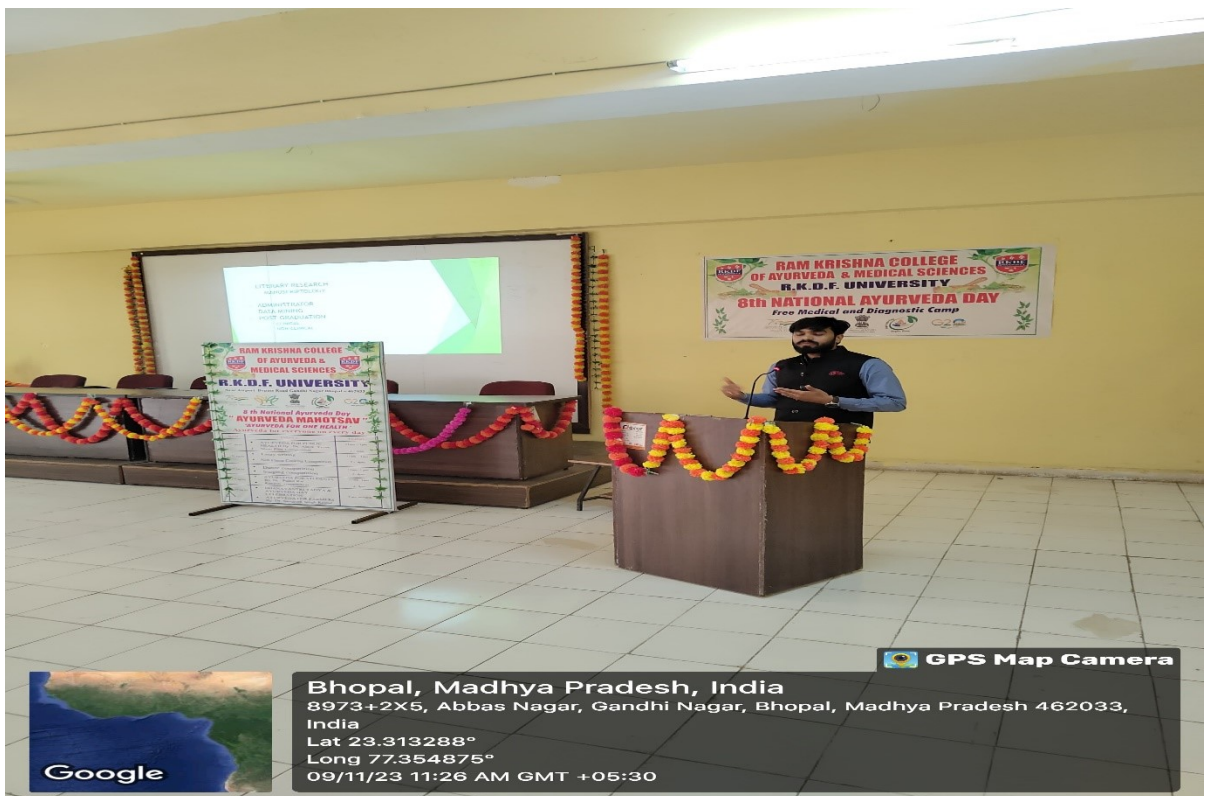
